

Inception: 1905



**DOUÉ-EN-ANJOU**  
**Moulin Touchais**  
Inception: 1787

Founded in 1787, the Domaine Touchais is one of the oldest wine estates in Anjou. After more than 230 years, its reputation is still as prestigious as ever. Its renown is based on the production of fine Coteaux de Layon vins de garde, which are recommended in many Michelin-starred restaurants throughout the world and which benefit from a minimum of 10 years' ageing in the cellar.

**SAUMUR**  
**Albert Besombes**  
Inception: 1872

Present in the Saumur region for over 150 years, this is the group's oldest entity. Bringing together 550 winegrowers, Albert Besombes is one of the main winegrower-merchants in the Loire Valley.
